Cold Weather- Please help your student be prepared for the colder weather by making sure he/she has a coat, jacket, sweatshirt, etc., each day.

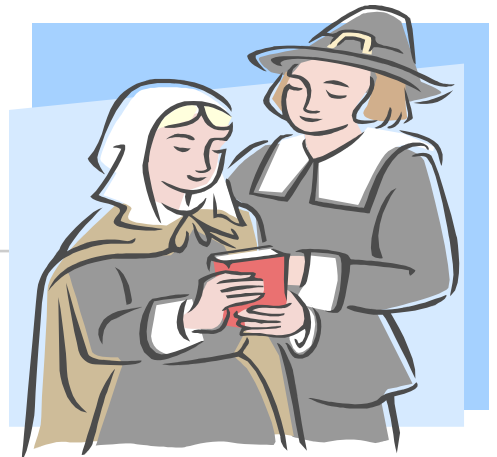
Auction Helper- Kim Graham has volunteered to be in charge of the second grade class auction project. Thank you, Kim! She would appreciate another
