The Young Rembrandts drawing class

is coming back to Forest Hills in a couple of weeks! If your K-5 student loves drawing this is the place for them on Monday afterschool! We believe that anyone can draw, and offer basic technique and instruction. Each week students complete a full lesson--starting with a blank piece of paper and finishing with a colored masterpiece. This winter in Young Rembrandts drawing class your child will learn about basic design and composition as they draw their own dollar bill. Good color selection and proper coloring technique will be emphasized in many of our lessons, including in the optical illusion lesson. Besides strengthening your child's drawing and coloring skills, he or she will also learn about art history as we present lessons featuring master artists such as Gilbert Stuart and Picasso. 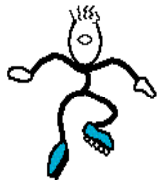

Forest Hills has had a relationship with TADS for four years. They currently process your electronic tuition payments, financial aid analysis, and enrollment contracts.

- Each family will be receiving an email from TADS.
- The email will contain a link to re-enroll online.
- You will receive an email for each child you have enrolled - however you only need to open one email and click on the link one time.
- We will re-enroll current students January 16 - February 10.
- As in the past, the fee to re-enroll is \$75 per student.
