Tuition Set for 2010-2011

We appreciate your support and partnership as together we educate your children. Each one of our Forest Hills families plays a vital role in the school. Most of our current 160 students have re-enrolled for next year. If you have not done so, we encourage you to contact the school. We have been blessed with a number of interested families interested in enrolling in the fall!

In preparation for the 2010-2011 school year, the board voted on a 1.5% increase in tuition. This equals \$75.00 per child per year. This decision was made keeping our families and the economy in mind. We encourage you to apply for tuition assistance if the tuition investment is difficult for you at this time. We ask you to go to www.tuitionaid.com to complete an application by March, 31, 2010.

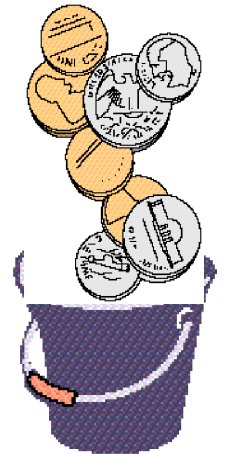
The Return of the Puppets

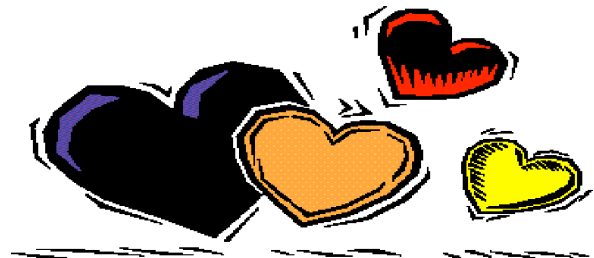
