As we prepare for the 2010-2011 school year we are asking that if you plan to apply for financial aid, that the online application must be completed by **March 31, 2010**.

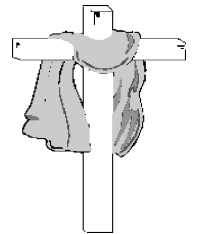
