Our team had a great showing on Tuesday at Portland Christian for the district track meet. Here are some highlights

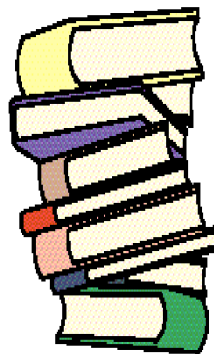

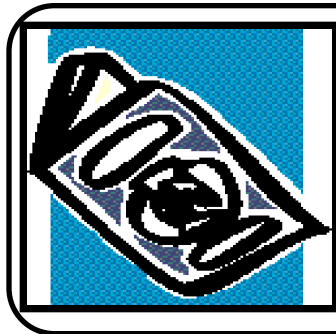
Library News
