Parents and friends of the school are invited to join us each Wednesday, beginning at **8:20 a.m.** at St. Peter's Church, next door to the school.

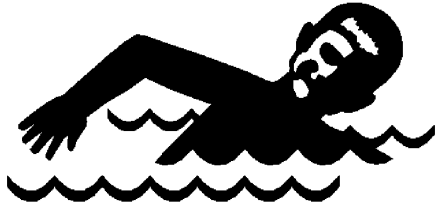


### **Halloween Dress-Up Guidelines**

## "Portrait Day Take Two"



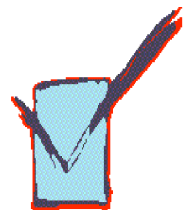

## Schedule Immunizations NOW!

Within the next few weeks, the school office will be notifying you of any immunizations that your child may be missing to meet the State of Oregon's requirements.

Children who are in **Kindergarten through 12th grade** for the 2009-2010 school year, are required to have the following doses of the following immunizations:

- Td/DT ~ 5
- Polio ~ 4
- MMR ~ 2
- Varicella (Chicken Pox) ~ 1 OR a history of the disease.
- Hepatitis B ~ 3 shot series

**7th and 8th graders** need to receive a Tdap booster after the age of 10 to help protect against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis.
