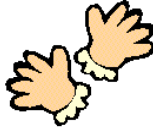
dropped off each day. Our focus will still be PB and J, but this year we are also teaming with other Christian schools, Banks Christian Academy and St. Francis Catholic school to provide

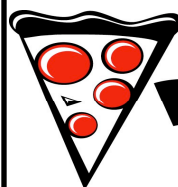
