Miss Reitmeier will host this information meeting on Thursday, May 27 starting at 3:15 p.m. in the library.

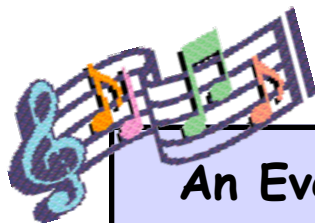
Summer Spanish

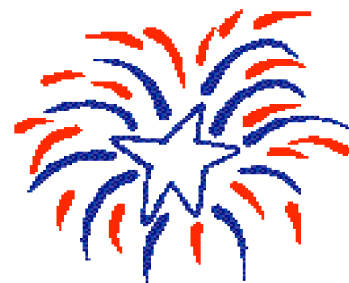
