Running Club for students in K-4

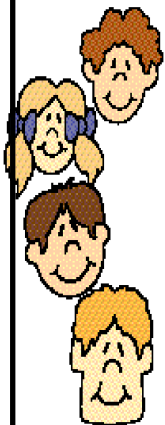
The club will meet after school on Mondays and Thursdays from 3 - 3:30 p.m. for the months of September - October.
